Divorce

A divorce legally ends a marriage. A divorce is called “dissolution” or “dissolution of marriage.” To get divorced, one person must file a document called a petition. The petition must be served on the Respondent (your spouse). Your spouse may file a “response.” However, you and your spouse may still reach an agreement.

An uncontested divorce means that the parties agree on all issues; for example: every settlement agreement or divorce decree must deal with five basic issues. These issues deal with: 1) alimony, if any, 2) property division and, if there are children, 3) custody, 4) visitation, and 5) child support. These five issues must be determined by the divorcing couple in order to obtain an uncontested divorce. If you and your spouse agree on everything and put it in writing, you have an uncontested divorce.

Living Trust

A revocable living trust allows you to avoid probate while managing your own estate. The significance of a fully funded revocable living trust is that it survives at your death and holds your assets for you, therefore at your death, there is nothing for the court to probate.

Probate can be a long, expensive process that simply does not have to occur in many situations. To avoid probate, a person or married couple can place their assets in a “trust” while keeping full control over their property. The trust has actual ownership of the property although you own the trust throughout your lifetime; it is called “revocable” because you can alter your estate plan anytime during your lifetime and even revoke the entire trust if you choose. It is called a trust because it creates an entity where assets can be placed for normal use during your lifetime and then be available for distribution to anyone you select after your death.

Incorporations

Incorporation means creating a new corporation. A corporation is an organization that is approved by your state to conduct business. In the eyes of the law, a corporation is a real person. It can own things and it can enter into agreements. Also, just like a person, it can sue and be sued.

Most people form corporations to protect their personal assets because the owners of a corporation are generally not personally responsible for the corporation's debts. This is called “limited liability protection.”

The personal liability protection is available to owners of C corporations, S corporations, and limited liability companies. The personal liability protection is not available to owners of a sole proprietorship or a general partnership.
